Job Description

The Upper Humber Settlement is looking to hire a student for the 2022 summer season. This position would be ideal for any indigenous student interested in studies or careers in the agriculture or tourism industries. The employee's role on the FarmStay B&B will be diverse including some farm duties and some hospitality duties. Student employee will be working closely with the supervisor. All employees are also expected to participate in weekly team meetings.

Please note that the student's job duties are subject to change depending on the interest of the student and the plans for future study. If a student is more interested in Tourism or Agriculture their responsibilities will be reflective of their intended field of study.

Some Responsibilities include but are not limited to;

- Checking guests in and out of B&B
- Assisting with B&B daily housekeeping including but not limited to laundry and cleaning floors
- Assisting with some daily Farm chores including but not limited to watering greenhouse, weeding, transplanting and harvesting
